GM'S notes

Hi Everyone,

How lucky can you get, we had a hot, dry day in the wet season! As we had chosen a site with no shelter, we were very grateful that the rain held off until the last hashers were getting in their cars to go home.

We set the run in the morning and our co-hares were Justbeer and Akz Hole who were very patient with the slow pace and the number of wrong turns we took – many thanks guys.

Over the course of the evening 43 members and 9 guests (Kissinger, Kiss me, Golden Cock, Snake Charmer, Funny Bunny, Rudy, Chian, Leo and Julian) arrived at the site. 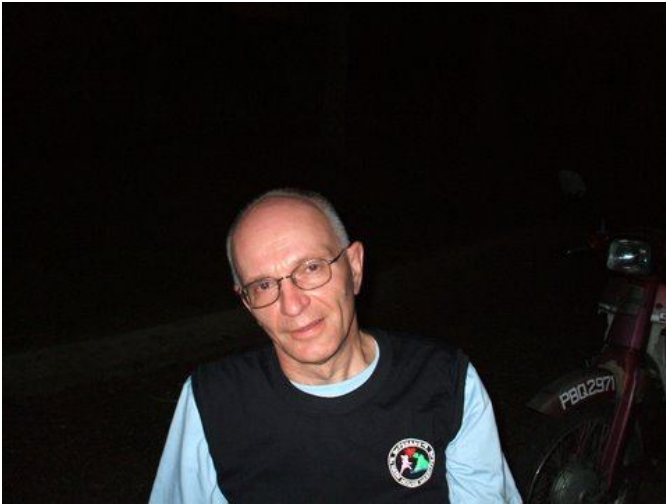
