However just when we thought we still had a long way to go the trail took a left turn up a short but steepish incline and low and behold we were on the top of the old Chili Farm. The view was quite wonderful and it's a place we never seem to get to now as the paths are all overgrown. Down the other side we went, sliding on the loose gravel until we hit the path that takes you to Batu Gantong and T45. A left here and then all the way back through the Lemongrass on the 45/39 trail downwards and back through Youth Park to the New Information Centre.

In all a good run, one steep climb, good views and a good work out. Thanks Grandma.
