LANTERN RUN

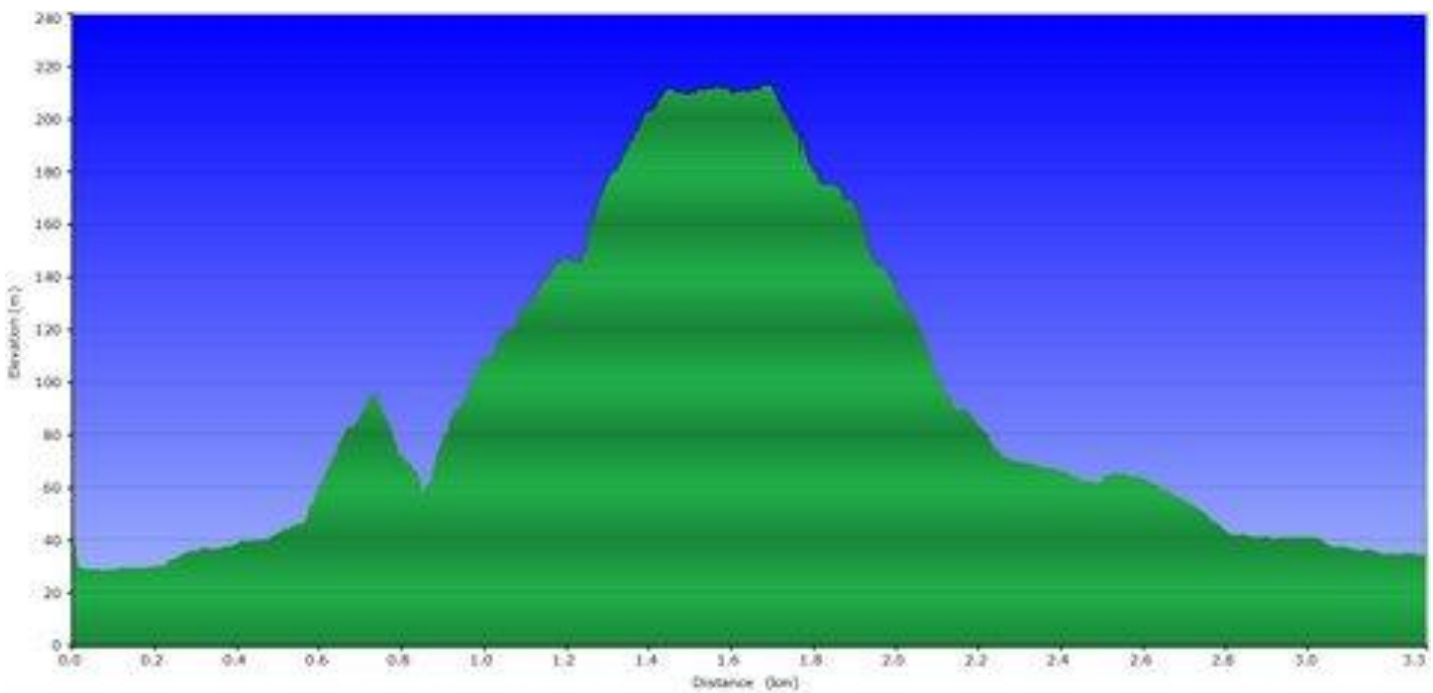
