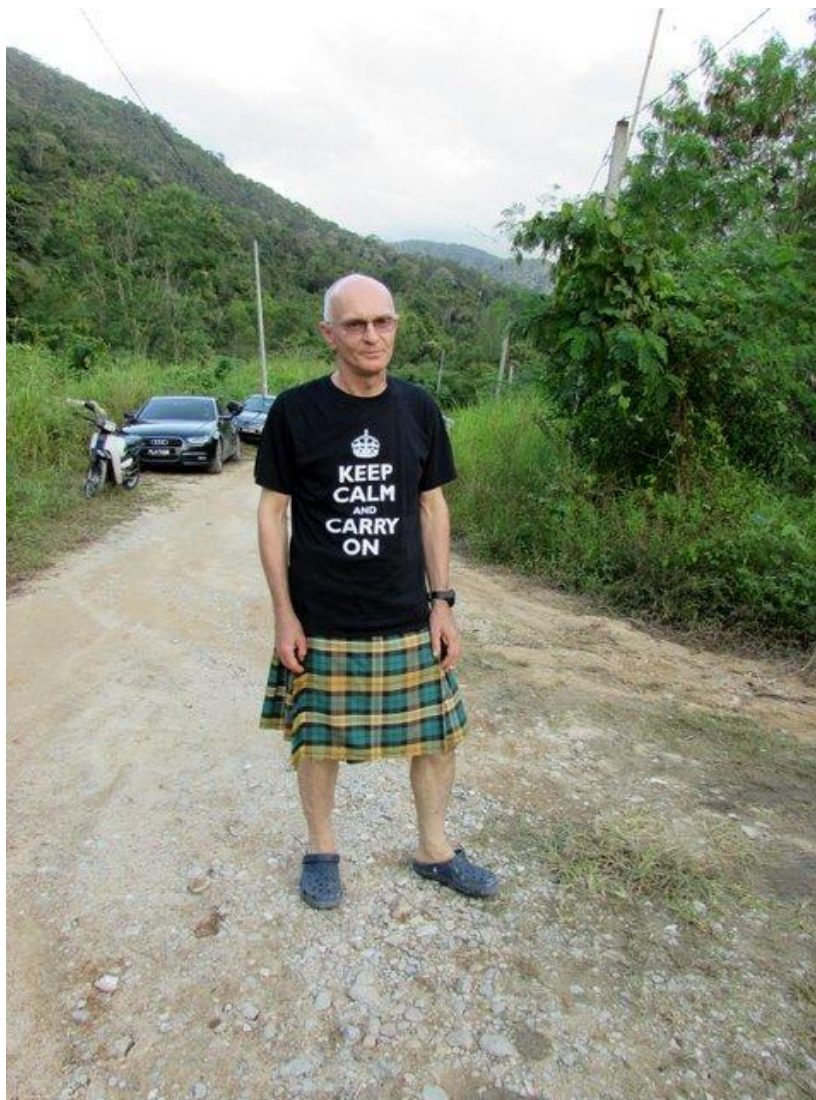
to get her feet wet. She stated that she was waiting at one point for a good Samaritan to carry her across but no-one did!!
